## IMPORTANT INFORMATION



Like so many other things, the NCS Library is operating a bit differently this school year. The actual library is closed to students. But, library classes will be coming to the classrooms via Miss Krahn and her 'library cart'! Your child(ren) may have already experienced their first 'library cart class'! Some things that are important for parents to note:

-If your child would like to bring their library book home, they must have a plastic/waterproof library book bag to take it home in. If a student does not have a bag, they will be asked to leave their book in the classroom. Students' library book bags **MUST** be returned with their library book **EVERY TIME**.

-Students can keep their library book for 2-weeks. We do not have overdue fees. However, if a book is lost or damaged while in a student's care, they will be asked to pay a fee so that we can replace that book with a new copy. Students will also not be permitted to sign-out new books until their overdue books are returned.

-Students in Grades 4-12 are encouraged to log-in to the NCS Online Library catalog to place a HOLD on specific books that they would like to read. The library catalog link can be found on our NCS website (on the main page, and also under 'student links'), and students will log-in using their Google account information.

-Students in Grades 1-3 are welcome to use the online catalog to search for library books that they would like to read. Inside of their library book bag every week they will receive a 'library book request ticket'. If they find a book they would like to sign-out, or if they know what kind of book they would like to read, they can fill out this ticket and return it to school inside of their library book bag, along with their current library book.

-Kindergarten students will pick a new book from a specific selection of books every week.

You can place your order on [scholastic.ca](http://scholastic.ca) (click on the 'Reading Club' tab at the top of the page) and your order will be shipped directly to your home. 



### Are you missing a book?
