Eligibility & Selection Criteria

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a Canadian citizen or a Permanent Resident, and Alberta resident who is completing their Grade 12 at Noble Central School.
- Applicant plans to enroll full-time at any recognized post-secondary institution in Canada. Proof of enrollment must be included in application. Students must apply in the year they graduate from high school. Students may only apply once for this award.

Selection

- The scholarship will be awarded based on academic achievement in Grade 12 and volunteer service to the community.
- A family panel will review applications and consult with school representatives as required. The decision of the panel is final.

Application Deadline

- June 1
- Send completed application and supporting materials to the NCS school office.
